The FNECDC was created in 2007 in order to develop a B.C. First Nations ECD Agenda and Action Plan to improve the well-being of First Nations children from prenatal to six years. The FNECDC has been endorsed by BC First Nations leadership, and FNECSC has been assisting with the organization of FNECDC meetings and facilitating activities.

The FNECDC has developed a discussion paper and draft framework to facilitate a province-wide discussion that describes proposed strategies and approaches to advance First Nations early childhood development.
