English First Peoples Grades 10-12 courses offer students of all backgrounds the opportunity to explore First Peoples' worldviews through written, oral, visual and digital texts. The courses were developed through the collaboration of First Nations Education Steering Committee with the BC Ministry of Education. English First Peoples (EFP) 12 is the academic equivalent to English Studies 12 for BC Dogwood Graduation Diploma and for post-secondary entrance requirements.

At this workshop, participants will hear from educators across the province who have been successful in having EFP 10, 11 and/or 12 courses offered in schools in their districts, and will be supported with ideas about how to move through potential barriers in their local contexts to be able to provide these rich courses for all students. This workshop focusses on successfully getting the courses "up and running" (not the resources for the courses).
