The Special Education Coach is part of a multi-disciplinary team and is responsible for providing special education support services directly to students, staff, and community members associated with BC First Nations schools.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist school personnel in the development and implementation of individual education plans and the collaborative team process;
- Provide information/training about relevant special education programs and services to school personnel and community members;
- Ability to conduct Level B assessments complete with reports and recommendations;
- Collaborate with the FNESC multi-disciplinary team assigned to the school.
- Research new trends and materials in the field of special education;
- Provide professional development through presentations and workshops in schools, trainings and conferences as assigned;
- Other projects as assigned by the Director, Special Education.

Qualifications/ Requirements:

- Bachelor of Education, including Special Education certification and training, and BC Teacher Regulation Branch certification
- Three or more years of experience working in the field of Special Education and/or at a variety of grade levels. Experience working with First Nations in the field of education an asset
- Excellent interpersonal and cross-cultural skills to work in a First Nations environment
- Comprehensive understanding of First Nations education issues and First Nations issues in British Columbia
- Flexibility to travel to First Nations schools throughout British Columbia. Possession of a valid Class 5 driver's license

Hours:

This is a full time/part time contract position with hours during the school year. The Employee shall perform his/her duties at such places and during such times as may be reasonably necessary.

Regionally based within the province of BC.
